- Regional Collection:** Yes, we will participate in the regional collection, giving residents access to all 12 collection events. We understand that our portion of the \$6,600 shared program costs will be charged at the beginning of the collection program, and that we will be charged \$31/unit after each collection event.
- Depot Access Only:** No, we will not be participating in the regional collection. We understand that our residents only have access to the Lewiston Depot collections. In addition, if we choose to allocate a budget we will be charged \$40 /unit after each collection event. Without a budget, residents will pay \$40/unit.
